

HOME FOOTBALL GAME ITINERARY

Arrive at the Ivan Jones Stadium wearing your

- band shirt
- band bibbers
- band hat
- athletic shorts
- long black socks
- band shoes
- gloves
- COLORGUARD will arrive in full uniform with hair and make-up already done.

5:15pm – Students arrive at Ivan Jones Stadium to unload the truck and put on uniform pants. Jackets will be put on prior to Halftime performance.

5:45pm – Students are grabbing equipment and heading to warm-up with their section leaders behind the Home-Side Stadium bleachers.

6:10pm – Students arc up to run music together with directors. COLORGUARD will continue working with Mr. Todd and Ms. HP.

6:25pm – Parents are moving drum major podiums into position for Pregame and preps to “block traffic” so band can enter the stadium without people walking through the band.

6:30pm – Band lines up to head into the stadium for Pregame.

6:45pm – Pregame begins

7:00pm – KICK-OFF

9:30pm-10:00pm – GAME ENDS and students take their instruments/equipment and load them onto the trailer. Students put uniforms back on the rack in the proper place. Once that is done, students are free to go home.

AWAY FOOTBALL GAME ITINERARY

Arrive at the Band Room wearing your

- band shirt

4:00pm – Students arrive at Band Room to load busses

4:30pm - Busses depart for destination

Arrive at Stadium – Loading Crew unload the trailer while everyone else puts on their uniform pants.

Once dressed and/or equipment has been procured, students head to warm-up with their section leaders until called by directors for group playing.

Depending on the stadium, parents are moving drum major podiums, PA speakers, and Front Ensemble into position for Halftime.

6:30pm – Band heads to bleachers in preparation of Home team’s pregame ceremony.

7:00pm – KICK-OFF

3rd Quarter - Parents/Guardians wishing to check out their student, may sign out their student with designated Chaperone next to the Band PA speaker. Understand that student “sign-outs” means that students will not be riding the bus home with the band. They are not dismissed until the game is over and all of their equipment and uniform have been properly loaded.

9:30pm-10:00pm – GAME ENDS and students take their instruments/equipment and load them onto the trailer. Students put uniforms back on the rack in the proper place. Once that is done, students load busses for departure.

Once busses arrive back at Foley HS, make sure your bus is clean and you are dismissed to go home.
